Power to Ukraine – Generator Appeal February 2023

 Donations from plant and hire industry supporters fund the purchase of 135 generators for families, schools, shelters and community centres close to the front line







Bath Abbey Concert February 2023

- Jeremy Fish represents the Plant and Hire Aid Alliance at a Bath concert to raise funds to buy a generator for the children's hospital at Oleksandriya, Southwest Ukraine. The concert is attended by 600 people.
- The Plant and Aid Alliance purchases a generator that is partly funded by JCB. PHA members fund the transport to Oleksandriya









Ambulance, Generator Campaign, Other Donations & PlantWorx May, June 2023

- Funds are raised from Plant and Hire Aid alliance members, supporters and members of the public to buy an ambulance and an additional 100kVA generator for the main hospital in central Oleksandriya
- A 40ft artic of donations is despatched to Oleksandriya








The Plant and Hire Aid Alliance is recognised at PlantWorx in June 2023 for its outstanding contribution to Ukraine humanitarian aid



2 x 750kW generators for the Munipal Water Treatment Plant of Sumy, Northeast Ukraine

- The treatment plant provides drinking water for over 250,000 people
- The generators were donated by McLaren as part of a building refurbishment in Oxford Circus, Central London
- This was a complex project that required the generators to be lifted off the building and transported on 4 HGVs to a nearby compound where they were transported to Ukraine
- Donations from Plant and Hire Aid Alliance members funded the transport.







Donations from The Scrubbery July 2023

Over 255 pallets of hospital scrubs were delivered, requiring 8 x 40 ft artic trucks which were funded by Plant and Hire Aid Alliance members.









Third Convoy October 2023

750 boxes of aid delivered

Aid included food, blankets, generators, medicinal products, clothes, rechargeable battery packs, torches







Many of our supplies were delivered to the 128th battalion who were at the front line in Zaporizhzhia. The battalion is Ukraine's second oldest ground forces regiment. Today it includes doctors, managers, chefs, volunteers and professional people who are at the edge of Europe fighting for their freedom. This flag was signed by members of the battalion and send to Jeremy Fish as a 'thank you' to the Plant and Hire Aid Alliance for their assistance. A few days later we were informed that all the signatories to this flag had been killed when an informant had betrayed their position at an awards ceremony. 28 soldiers were killed and 35 wounded when a Iskander missile was fired at the battalion.







Children's Christmas Present Appeal

 The Plant and Hire Aid Alliance despatched 15,000 wrapped gifts, 14 tonnes of flour, 4 tonnes of feminine hygiene products, 1 tonne of pet food, 3 tonnes of clothes







Wrapathon December 2023

- 100 volunteers from plant and hire companies and members of the public
- Wrapped 7,200 gifts at Framlingham High School, Suffolk









Arrival of Gifts December 2023

 Rotary distributed the gifts to orphanages in Transcarpathia and border towns in the conflict zone including Kharkiv, Zaporizhzhia, Kupiansk, Dnipro, Kramatorsk, Chuguyiv, Kherson, Borova and Odesa









Donation of Generators December 2023

• 23 generators – 13 to Odesa, 7 to Kharkiv and 3 to Gammalsvensky



Generators from our English and Slovak partners are starting to arrive in different institutions in the region.

Today, the new Daewoo generator GDA8500E-3 was handed over by Lyceum N4 of the Black Sea City Council for use in a protective hideout where schoolchildren are hiding and waiting for the end of the air alarm.

Representatives of the BF "Southern Capital", including my oldest daughter Victoria, who helps a lot in my work with her husband Dmytro, told the teachers of the lyceum how this charity cargo got into Chernomorsk.



It's time for your Christmas give away!


